Youth Apprenticeship Program



- New green-transit training and apprenticeship program
- Collaboration led by Canal Alliance for recruiting, training, job placement, and job support
- Funded by a California Opportunity Youth Apprenticeship (COYA) Grant
- Supports Marin Transit's commitment to green jobs and community engagement
- Excellent use for the workforce development component of FTA grant funds

2025/26 School Transportation Program Changes

Supplemental School Changes

- **Redwood HS** (Route 613/619) – Removed low ridership early morning routes, added afternoon capacity on 613
- **Lagunitas MS** (Route 625) – Added afternoon service to Woodacre to respond to student requests

Fixed Route Changes Related to School Needs

- Retimed Route 29 (**Redwood HS, Hall MS**), Route 61 (**Tamalpais HS**), and Route 68 (**Archie Williams**) to better meet bell times

Ross Valley Yellow Bus Updates

- Surpassed 2024/25 pass sales
- Sold out 4/6 afternoon routes, 2/7 morning routes
- Restructured morning Butterfield routes in August to offer +20 seats for Sleepy Hollow community

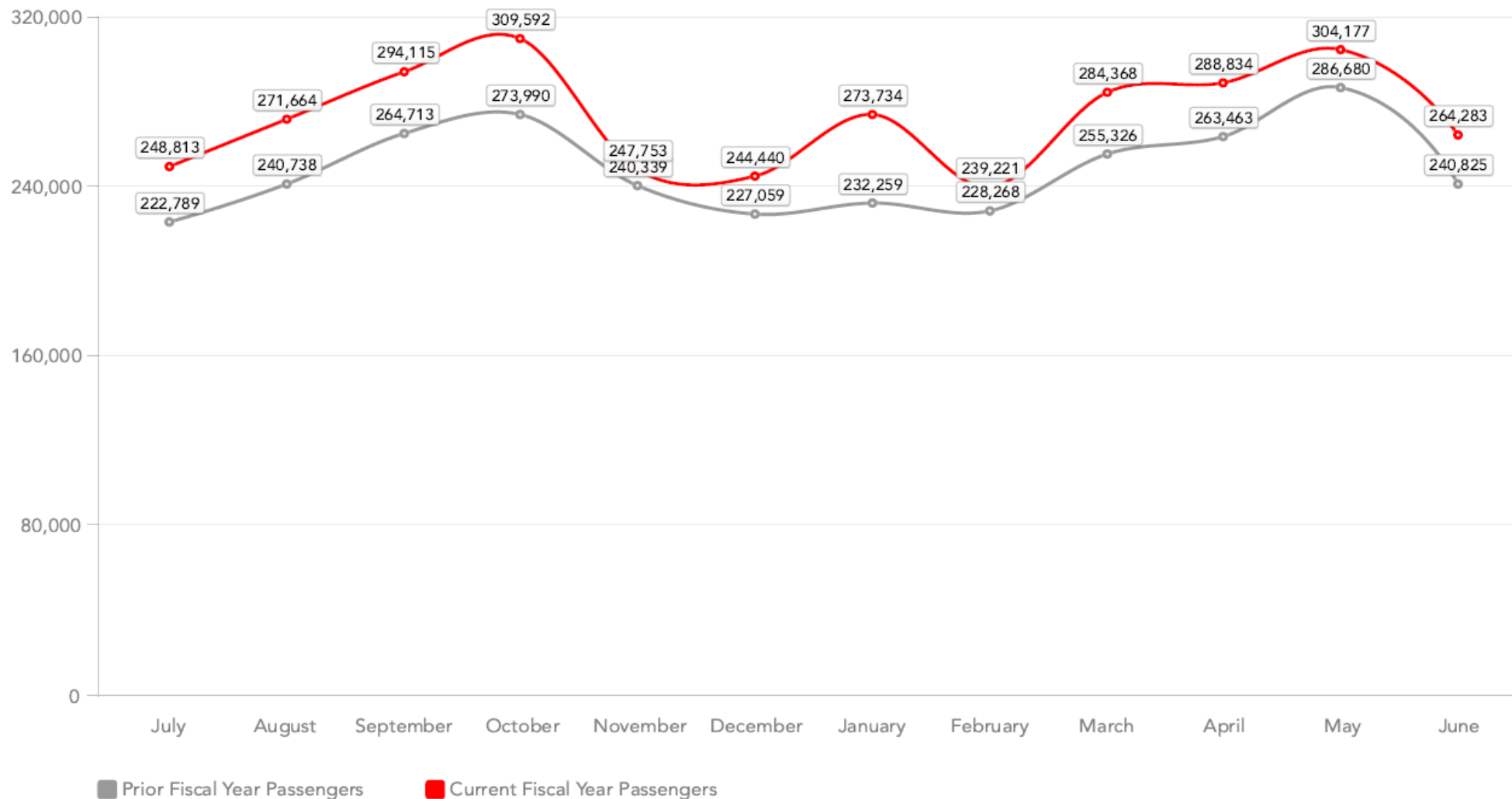
September is Transit Month!



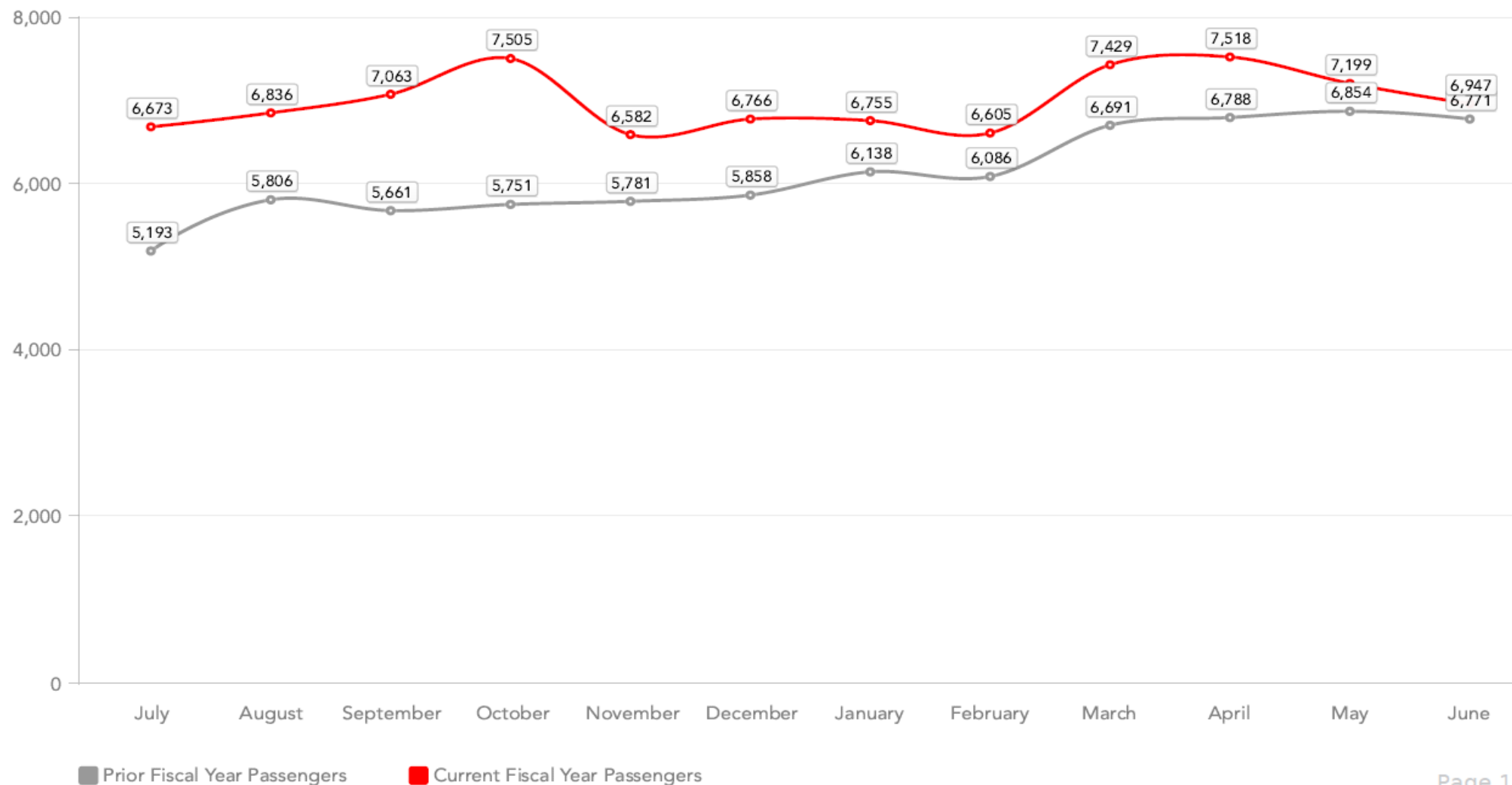
- Transit Month 2025 is a celebration of the role of public transportation in our communities.
