





Marin Transit Website Transition

- On February 1, 2026 the Marin Transit website and staff emails transitioned from .org to .gov
 - www.marintransit.org > www.marintransit.gov
 - info@marintransit.org > info@marintransit.gov
- Changes were made to enhance the security of both the website and e-mail, and comply with federal and state regulations
- The same information and resources are available on the website, just at a new link!
 - Email forwarding and website redirects are in place for users that continue use .org links or emails
 - Community members were notified of the changes via Marin Transit's e-newsletter



Transit Equity Day



On February 4, 2026, the District offered a fare promotion in honor of Transit Equity Day allowing all Marin Transit local bus riders to travel for free!


Bus Stop Lighting Assessment Project

- Staff from the Capital team are assessing night time lighting at bus stops across the County
- Priority locations include the Canal neighborhood and West Marin
- The project is aimed at responding to rider feedback and concerns about lighting at bus stops
- During the assessment:
 - Staff measure the lighting at the bus stop with a tool called a light meter
 - Any identified lighting issues or other maintenance concerns are referred to the operations team for follow-up




FTA 5310 Grant Award

- In February, staff were notified from FTA that Marin Transit was **awarded ~\$680k in federal 5310 funding**
- The goal of the FTA 5310 Program is to **improve the mobility of seniors and individuals with disabilities** by removing barriers to transportation services and **expanding the transportation mobility options** available
- This award will fund **Travel Navigator staffing** and offset the cost of subsidies distributed via the **mobility wallet**




San Rafael Transit Center Relocation Funding

 - Awarded \$25.6M in Federal grant funding for Buse / Bus Facilities
 - Final funding piece on this \$67M project




Fixed Route Ridership – October/November 2025
